Important Information

- There is no cost to enter the Rose Hill Fall Festival Parade.
- The Parade staging & judging will be held in the USD 394 High School Parking Lot.
- Competition floats should arrive no later than 9:30 am and check-in with a Parade Official, who will direct them to their assigned location. Judging will begin at **10:00 am sharp**. Any competition floats that are not in position by 10:00 am will not be judged.
- Non-competition floats should arrive no later than 10:15 am and check-in with a Parade Official.
- Failure to be in the assigned location on time may forfeit the entrant's rights, and may cause them to be placed in the back of the line.
- **Parade will start promptly at 11:00 am.** The Parade will start at the High School & end at Berlin St.
- Additional details will be emailed to all registered participants the week of Oct. 4th.

Basic Rules

- Parade position is determined by the Parade Committee and is subject to change at our discretion.
- Wrapped candy may only be tossed (gently) from the participants walking in the parade. Candy **CANNOT** be thrown from the floats or vehicles.
- Please be careful of the children running into the street to retrieve candy.
- All vehicles, floats, horses and participants must remain in the assigned parade formation on the street at all times. Riding/walking in the ditches and easements is not permitted.
- Horses will always go to the back of the lineup
- The Parade Committee reserves the right to determine other rules and procedures, if needed.

Parade applications must be received by Friday, October 1st, otherwise participants will be placed at the back of the parade on a first come, first served basis.

By participating in the RH Fall Festival Parade, you are acknowledging that an inherent risk of exposure to COVID-19 exists in any public place where people are present.
