#### **Important Information**

- There is no cost to enter the Rose Hill Fall Festival Parade.
- Instructions for parade staging will be sent out the week of Fall Festival.
- Competition floats should arrive no later than 9:30 am and check-in with a Parade Official, who will direct them to their assigned location. Judging will begin at **10:00 am sharp**. Any competition floats that are not in position by 10:00 am will not be judged. 1<sup>st</sup> place - \$300/2<sup>nd</sup> place - \$200/3<sup>rd</sup> place - \$100
- Non-competition floats should arrive no later than 10:15am and check-in with a Parade Official.
- Failure to be in the assigned location on time may forfeit the entrant's rights, and may cause them to be placed in the back of the line.
- **Parade will start promptly at 11:00 am.** The Parade will start at the High School & end at Berlin St.
- Additional details will be emailed to all registered participants the week of Oct. 7<sup>th</sup>.

#### **Basic Rules**

- Parade position is determined by the Parade Committee and is subject to change at our discretion.
- Wrapped candy may only be tossed (gently) from the participants walking in the parade. Candy **CANNOT** be thrown from the floats or vehicles.
- Please be careful of the children running into the street to retrieve candy.
- All vehicles, floats, horses and participants must remain in the assigned parade formation on the street at all times. Riding/walking in the ditches and easements is not permitted.
- Horses will always go to the back of the lineup.
- The Parade Committee reserves the right to determine other rules and procedures, if needed.

**Parade applications must be received by Friday, October 4, otherwise participants will be placed at the back of the parade on a first come, first served basis.**
